The Event

It is anticipated that we will run 4 courses and each driver will have the opportunity to complete 2 runs on each course. Club Points will be allocated to each SCCNZ driver who runs in the event.

Regulations

Please ensure that your car and your personal clothing conform to the requirements set out in the current MotorSport Manual, Schedule A or AA as applicable. NO EXCEPTIONS TO THESE SCHEDULES WILL BE ALLOWED.

As a minimum:

- Securely mounted seat
- Safe Steering
- Effective brakes
- Covered Shoes
- No overalls or helmet are required

Note: Although this venue is in a semi-industrial area, it is none the less, noise-sensitive. We will therefore, not tolerate any deliberate driver action which creates undue noise, or smoke pollution (such as drifting or burnouts). This is a Motorkhana NOT A DRIFT EVENT. Maximum noise emissions from any vehicle MUST NOT EXCEED 95db(A). Vehicles deemed to be exceeding this will be automatically excluded from the event.

Who can Enter?

Driver entry to this event is primarily restricted to current SCCNZ members and members of other MotorSport NZ-affiliated clubs. Non-members of SCCNZ clubs may however be permitted to take part, as detailed in the MotorSport Manual, Appendix 5, Schedule C; however, if you have already participated in 2 previous events as a non-member you will need to become a member of SCCNZ or another MSNZ club to run in this event.

How to Enter?

The Entry form is a fillable PDF, which can be found on the <u>SCCNZ website</u>. You can fill it and digitally sign then email us, or send us a scanned completed copy or mail us a paper copy along with your Direct Credit of the entry fee.

Pre-entry requirements as detailed in Annex A to the Event Supplementary Regulations will be strictly adhered to.

Entries will close when the maximum number of cars allowed for this event is reached, namely 25 cars, or as otherwise detailed in Annex A. Entries will be accepted on the day if the event is not fully subscribed.

As entry numbers are limited, cutoff dates will be strictly enforced and order of entry will be based solely on when the entry form (either mail or email) and when a Direct Credit appears in our bank account. Entries will only be acknowledged by email.
