

AUTOCROSS EVENT – ARDMORE AIRFIELD

On Labour Day Monday, 27th October 2014, the Club will be running a further Autocross event at Ardmore Airfield. This event will take place on the western end of the non-operational Runway 07 (see photo).

Unfortunately, due to increased MotorSport NZ levies and fees, we have had to increase the Entry Fee to \$40 for a pre-event entry and \$60 for an on-the-day entry. Please check the information on the attached Annex A to the Supplementary Regs for this event – there have been changes.

Driver entry to this event will be restricted to current SCCNZ members and members of other MotorSport NZ-affiliated clubs ONLY. Passengers may NOT be carried in this event.

As this event is more advanced than a Motorkhana, MotorSport NZ and SCCNZ insist that drivers ensure that their vehicles and their personal safety equipment conform to the requirements set out in the New Zealand MotorSport Manual for drivers running in a ClubSport Basic - Autocross event – that is, your safety gear and your car must comply with Appendix 2, Schedule A, or if applicable, Appendix 6, Schedule AA of the MotorSport Manual. We will have scrutineering officials there to check compliance.

Event information and the Entry Form are being sent out to previous entrants and will also be available on our website. Please mail your entry to us (with the applicable fee), or scan and Direct Credit, well prior to the event. We are only accepting a maximum of 30 entries for this event. Although we reserve the right to accept late entries on the day, if you wait until then you may miss out. If your late entry is accepted, you will incur a heavy surcharge on the regular entry fee.
