

# **CIRCUIT SPRINT – PUKEKOHE PARK RACEWAY**

**On Sunday, 8<sup>th</sup> April 2012, the Club will be running its annual Circuit Sprint on the Pukekohe Park Raceway.**

**Driver entry to this event is restricted to current SCCNZ members and members of other MotorSport NZ-affiliated clubs ONLY. Passengers may be carried in this event providing the requirements for carriage as detailed in the current edition of the MotorSport Manual are met.**

**This event is the most advanced ClubSport event we run, so MotorSport NZ and SCCNZ insist that drivers in this event ensure that their vehicles and their personal safety equipment conform to the requirements set out in the New Zealand MotorSport Manual for entrants and/or drivers running in these ClubSport Advanced and ClubSport Basic – Circuit Sprint events. That is, your safety gear and your car must comply with Appendix 2, Schedule A, or if applicable, Appendix 6, Schedule AA of the MotorSport Manual. We will have scrutineering officials there to check compliance.**

**Note: Pukekohe Park Limited will have a noise monitoring facility in operation at the track during the running of this event. Maximum noise emissions from any vehicle MUST NOT EXCEED 95db(A). Vehicles exceeding this will be excluded from the event.....**

**Also, for entry to the Dual Car Sprint, you must hold a current MotorSport New Zealand Competition Licence. The minimum class of licence for this event is a ClubSport Licence.**

**For this event, we have made provision for one group of cars to run in a separate grid, under the Circuit Sprint (Single Car) format, to cater for drivers who do not hold a Competition Licence, or whose cars do not comply with the requirements for entry to the Dual Car grids. A maximum of 8 cars will be accepted for this grid, but if we receive less than 5 entries for this group, we will not be proceeding with this part of the event. Under these circumstances, any entries received for this group will either be offered a refund of entry, or offered re-allocation to a Dual Car grid. Any drivers who accept re-allocation will, of course, have to comply with the vehicle and licence requirements for a ClubSport Advanced event.**

**Please complete your Entry Form and mail it to us (with the applicable fee), well prior to the event. We are only accepting a maximum of 50 entries for this event. NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED ON THE DAY.**
