

AUTOCROSS EVENT – ARDMORE AIRFIELD

On Labour Day Monday, 24th October 2011, the Club will be running an Autocross event at a Ardmore Airfield. This event will take place on the western end of the non-operational Runway 07 and on parts of the adjacent taxiways.

Driver entry to this event will be restricted to current SCCNZ members and members of other MotorSport NZ-affiliated clubs ONLY. Passengers may NOT be carried in this event.

Although this event is in essence, very similar to a Motorkhana (which we stage regularly), it is a little more advanced, so MotorSport NZ and SCCNZ insist that drivers in this event ensure that their vehicles and their personal safety equipment conform to the requirements set out in the New Zealand MotorSport Manual for entrants and/or drivers running in a ClubSport Basic - Autocross event – that is, your safety gear and your car must comply with Appendix 2, Schedule A, or if applicable, Appendix 6, Schedule AA of the Manual. We will have scrutineering officials there to check compliance.

Please complete your Entry Form and mail it to us (with the applicable fee), well prior to the event. We are only accepting a maximum of 30 entries for this event. Although we reserve the right to accept late entries on the day, if you wait until then you may miss out. If your late entry is accepted, you will incur a heavy surcharge on the regular entry fee.
